

REVOCATION FLOWCHART

Can an ECO revoke?

YES

- Visit entry clearance activated.
- Any entry clearance not activated (ie not used to enter the UK).

- “REVOKED” stamp diagonally over the entry clearance (if post holds the passport).
- If the name of the revoking Post/section is unclear, a reference in manuscript should be made on the same page.
- eg: “refer to BE Abidjan”, “refer to Managed Migration”.
- Where not possible, a post may revoke following advice from the issuing Post.

- PROVISO updated.
- Application form updated.
- RAU informed (as appropriate).
- HO data bases alerted to requested revocation.
- Revocation Notice sent to applicant.
- Original decision reconsidered and, if applicant does not meet the Rules, issue a refusal notice.

NO

- Non-visit entry clearance activated (ie used to enter UK)

- Send email to HOferralsLon mailbox with subject heading: “Revocation Request”.
